While this class is not intended to teach you to be a cardiologist, it is intended to make EMS Responders of all levels competent in successfully obtaining a quality 12 lead EKG and build confidence in recognizing a STEMI (ST Elevation Myocardial Infarction) when valuable time counts in you patients outcome. The first portion of this four hour program teaches proper monitor settings, the essentials of skin preparation and the landmarks used to apply the EKG electrodes; all important points in ensuring your prehospital 12 Lead credibility. The second portion reviews the anatomy of the EKG complex, the affects of AMI on those complexes and the different viewpoints taken by the EKG monitor before putting it all together to read what these electrical waveforms are trying to tell you. Students are given several opportunities to practice throughout the class with provided practice material. Finally, the class will review and discuss how confident STEMI recognition and additional policies and procedures can improve your continuity of care, thereby improving the outcome of your patients
